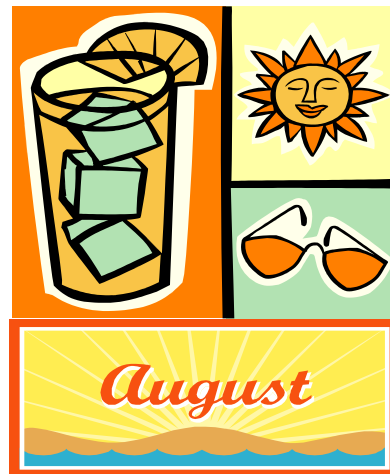

ARCHER LANE

Archer Lane is the lime rock road (formerly a dirt road) that runs alongside our wonderful new bike trail! It is going to be paved and now belongs to the City of Archer. The legal description of the road is:

All that part of County Road Archer Lane that lies between the easterly right of way line of State Road No. 45 and the westerly right of way line of S.W. 154th Street, according to a Maintenance Map filed in Maintenance Book 2, pages 80 through 91 of the public records of Alachua County Florida.
