

# Current Landscape Irrigation Restrictions in Alachua County

Updated June 2012

## Suwannee River Water Management District (SRWMD)

Starting June 13th, established lawns and landscapes may be irrigated a maximum of **once a week** between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. based on the address of the property.

Addresses ending in 0 or 1 - Monday

Addresses ending in 2 or 3 - Tuesday

Addresses ending in 4 or 5 - Wednesday

Addresses ending in 6 or 7 - Thursday

Addresses ending in 8 or 9 - Friday

Areas with no numbered address - Friday

The following are exempt: vegetable gardens, hand watering with a spray nozzle with an automatic shut off (allowed between 4 p.m. and 10 a.m.), use of reclaimed water, micro-irrigation, and new landscapes for the first 60 days.

## St. Johns River Water Management District (SJRWMD)

Established lawns and landscapes may be irrigated a maximum of **twice a week** between the hours of 4 p.m. and 10 a.m. based on the address of the property. These residents are asked to voluntarily limit irrigation to once a week.

Odd numbered homes - Wednesday and/or Saturday

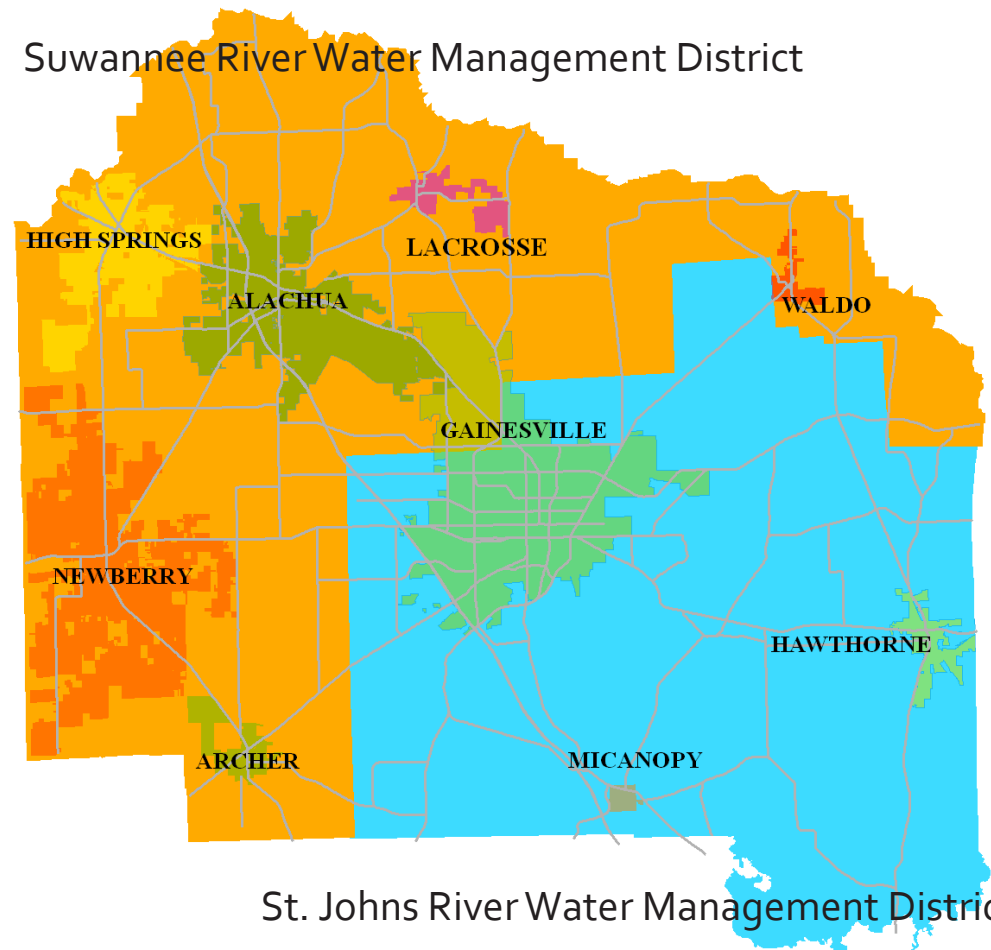
Even numbered homes - Thursday and/or Sunday

nonresidential properties - Tuesday and/or Friday

The following are exempt: vegetable gardens, hand watering with a spray nozzle with an automatic shut off, use of reclaimed water, micro-irrigation, and new landscapes for the first 60 days.
